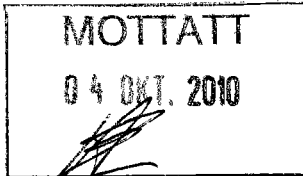

While I recognize the importance of the issue you described, on the basis of the current EU legal framework, the European Commission cannot take any action. Clearly, the law enforcement authorities of Luxembourg concerned by the alleged practices described are responsible for taking action.
