We refer to our previous correspondence in this matter, particularly of January 20, 26 and 31, and March 7 and 21 2011.


Enclosed you will find a CD containing a section of a conversation between notary Francis Kessler and us which took place on February 9 2011. As you might know by now, Kessler is the notary who – on behalf of the bank in question – attempts to carry out an illegal forced sale of our house. Consequently we are a party to his case, and have thus a right to defend ourselves against him. In this regard we have asked Kessler to provide us with all documents of which he is building his case on. Kessler has rejected our petitions for discovery, and in this phone conversation he made it pretty clear to us:

"I am not writing anything to you."


Where is the justice in this?

We are under constant attack from the Luxembourg authorities, but when we attempt to defend ourselves, then the same authorities deprive us of this right, a governance which only can be compared to the one of despots' in totalitarian states. This judicial, or rather anarchic situation is a direct consequence of Luxembourg's vigorous opposition to mandatory implementation of EU-law, e.g. the Charter of Fundamental Rights, and of EU's acceptance, looking the other way every time a problem of which it doesn't know the solution of surfaces. We will highly appreciate EU's immediate intervention in this matter hence avoiding further damages this country is inflicting on itself and its citizens.
